ORGANIZER'S GUIDE



Thank you so much for purchasing *Chasing Wonder: Photo Bingo Challenge*! At its heart, *Chasing Wonder* is a simple invitation: to slow down, notice God's beauty all around (even and especially in the broken places), and share what we discover.

CUSTOMIZE AND PRINT

- If you wish, there's a customizable field on the bottom left for your church name, and one on the bottom right for your website.
- Print up the bingo boards on 8.5 x 11 paper or cardstock, white or colored

EVERYONE CAN PLAY

Participants can aim for a single bingo, four corners, a full board, or invent their own creative combinations - the sky's the limit!

Participants simply:

- take original photos inspired by the prompts on the board
- mark off squares as they go
- share their photos on social media or email them to your church office (don't forget to tag your church!)

Chasing Wonder can be:

- a one-day event
- a week-long family challenge
- a summer-long church-wide activity
- a Vacation Bible School activity
- a youth group scavenger hunt
- a community arts project

☆ EVEN MORE ☆ WAYS TO CHASE WONDER

- Kick things off with a "Wonder Sunday" and bless participants before the challenge begins
- Use it as a summer faith formation challenge for the whole congregation
- Turn it into a "24 Hours of Wonder" all-church challenge
- Invite families to take a Sunday afternoon "Wonder Walk" together
- Build a sermon series around themes of noticing, wonder, awe, or everyday holiness
- Incorporate participant photos into worship, sermons, children's messages, newsletters, social media, and/or seasonal reflections
- Invite participants to share the story behind a favorite photo and what they noticed
- Host a celebration night with a shared meal and a community slideshow of favorite submissions
- Mail it out in late summer as a back-to-church re-engagement invitation
- Create playful categories and awards (Most Joyful, Best Perspective, Small but Mighty, Most Colorful, Most Unexpected)
